# RISK ASSESSMENT: Events with The Camper Stage

#### **Risks Before Event Arrival**

For transportation, the Camper Stage packs up and travels as a normal vehicle, towing the operating trailer if this is required. The Camper Stage is maintained to all legal requirements and checks on vehicle condition are undertaken before leaving the storage site. The driver will comply with all on site driving requirements such as speed limits and use of warning lights.
