Workers are to use their discretion and exercise caution when engaging in manual handling and should not participate if they do not consider themselves physically capable of the task.	Low	Stop the affected individual from working to prevent further injury. Call for a first aider if necessary.

Guy ropes / pegs	Becoming loose	Medium	Medium - High	Anchoring is a critical part of stability. Pegs should be inserted firmly into the ground and checked regularly. All guy ropes should be kept taut.	Low	Replace and adjust all anchors and guy ropes as required.
Uneven floor	Injury from tripping	Medium	Low - Medium	Select an area to erect the stage that is as flat as possible. Ensure that the stage platform itself is securely fastened, and check its status regularly during the event. High winds	Injury / death from collapse	Low	High	The stage should be attached to the ground as securely as possible. On hard standing where ground driven stakes cannot be used, suitable weights and tie points should be utilised. If high winds are predicted then the area should be evacuated, and erection or dismantling delayed if this is the safest option. Trips on and off the stage	Injury from falling	Medium	Low	Ensure that the stage is levelled and locked into position as soon as possible during setup. Ensure that steps are of appropriate heights and level. Ensure that all personnel on the stage are aware of the location of the	Low	Call for a first aider if necessary.

Power	Injury / death from electric shock	Low	High	The stage equipment has all been PAT tested by a competent professional and deemed suitable for use.	Low	Call for a first aider. Dial 999 to contact an ambulance if necessary.
Cable runs	Injury from trips or falls	Medium	Low	Cable runs to be kept neat and tidy. Any cross site runs should be buried or suitably covered.	Low	Call for a first aider if necessary.
